- You will need to provide names for gate security at least 24 hours prior to access
- Bring a hard hat with you.
- There is usually someone on site Tuesday and Sundays, access can be made on other days but a donation of £30 cash should be considered to cover the volunteers time.
- Site visits longer than an hour will be charged at £50+VAT per hour.

SITE INFORMATION

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The main complex of buildings at Crossness are Grade I listed.• Preparation/set dressing must not result in any permanent change to the building• No drilling holes, nailing, sticky tape, fixings of any kind are permitted and no painting
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The upper floors are grated so not good for those with vertigo or pointed heels.• The basement is small and cramped.• We need to give names of persons entering the site at least 24 hours prior to access.• Strictly no wandering allowed on Thames Waters land. See site map for routes.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• CET is situated wholly within Thames Water Sewage Treatment Works which is a lower tier Control of Major Accident Hazards site. There are strict H&S protocols to abide by. Certain areas have access restrictions including asbestos and noxious gases. Clients using these areas will need to show what provisions they are putting in place.• If an alarm is sounded, crew are to remain inside buildings unless the risk is inside then they should leave the site immediately and muster in the car park outside the gates.• Hard hats must be worn when in the Beam Engine House as the floor is pierced and items can fall through and injure those below.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The lighting within CET is rudimentary at best and there is no emergency lighting. • It is recommended that Production bring its own electricity supply for powering film lights. • On site there is 13 amp + 32 amp + 63 amp single supply on site see map for locations. • All cables must be ramped or matted to ensure safe passage.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The display units can be moved to provide space for seating up to 150 people. A small charge will be made to remove and replace furniture. • The Educational Suite has space for 40 people sitting. • There is a male, female and disabled toilet unit in the Display area. Production to leave clean and supply toilet paper. • Water tap in café area and toilets • Mains water outside by the valve house • Frequent hand washing should be encouraged and especially before eating as there can be airborne particles present.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • WIFI Is available on site for a small charge. • The Educational Suite has an overhead projector, laptop and sound system via HMI link.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The food preparation/café area in the Boiler House can be used. • Hot water urns are available. • Production may bring in its own catering. Cooking allowed on site.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parking surrounding CET for 30 cars or 4 trailers and 15 cars. • A car park is available before the security gates with parking for 59 cars. • Access routes must be kept clear for emergency vehicles at all times.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leave the site clean and tidy or a charge will be made for cleaning • Rubbish should be removed daily organised and paid by the production • Any signage needs removing upon departure or a cost applied.

LOCATION HIRE FEES

There will always be a location hire fee even for student projects.

Location hire fees range from £1,800 to £3,500 for a 12 hour day and payment is prior to access.

Locality will provide a quote depending upon the type of production and how many people are on site.

There is a charge for staff covering access

INSURANCE

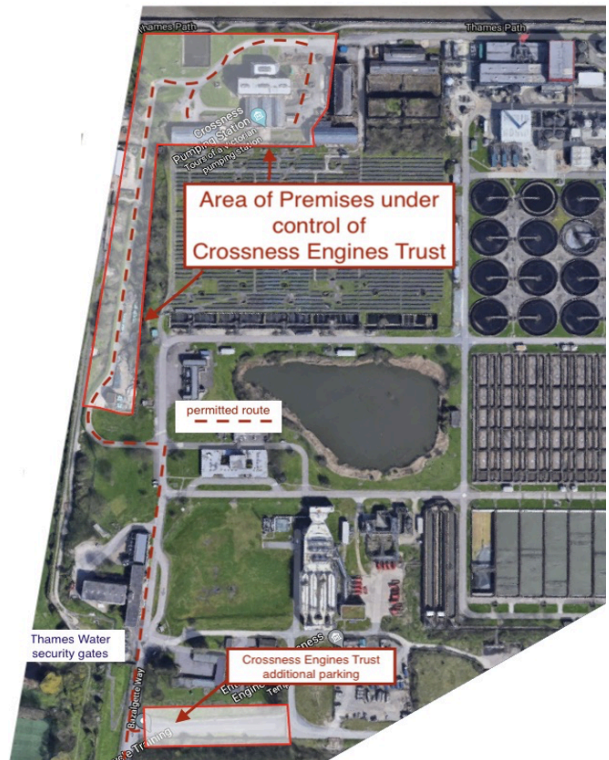
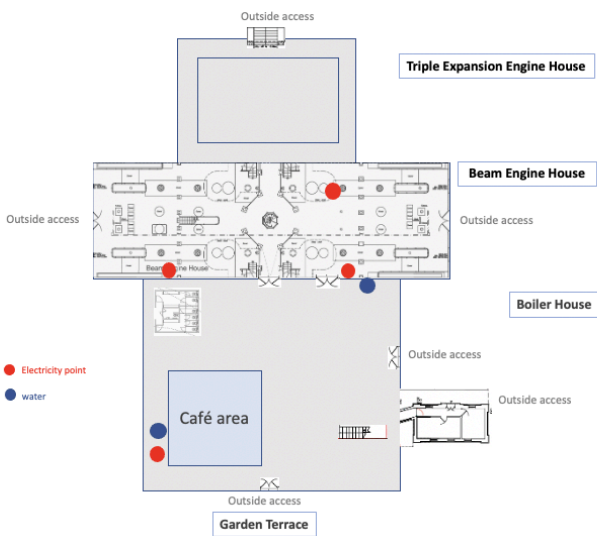
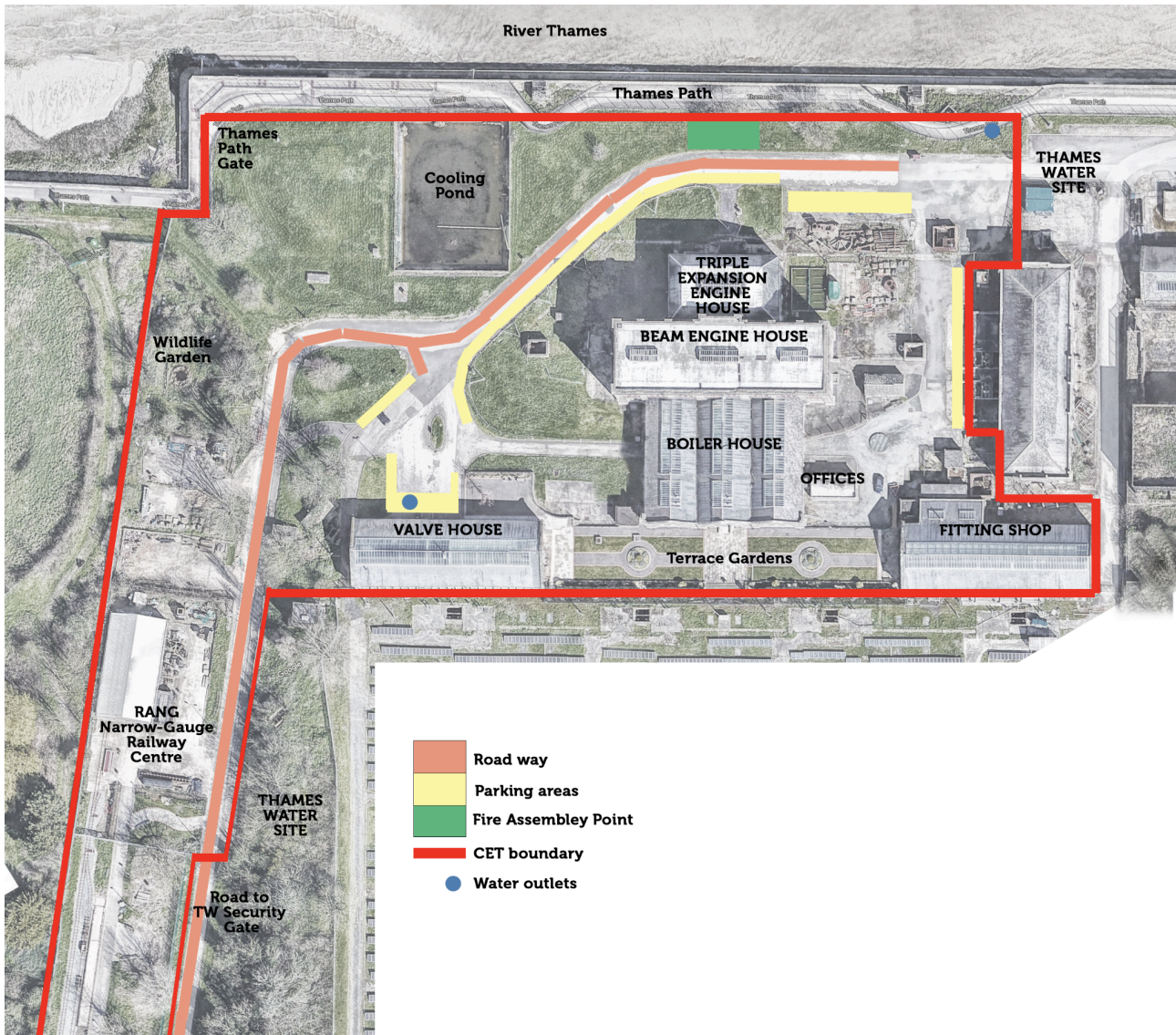
You need public liability insurance of over £5 million

DEPOSITS

We require Production to pay a deposit that is held against any damage or additional fees incurred. The amount differs with the amount of people on site but the minimum held is £2,000
